### From the School Nurse:

#### Medications at School



If a student's physician recommends that the student receive prescription or over-the-counter medication during the school day, a medication form signed by the student's licensed health care provider is required. Forms are available on the Monsignor Slade Catholic School website and can be found under the Forms & Documents section of the Parents tab.

Medication, both prescription and non-prescription, can only be dispensed with this medication form, signed by the health care provider and parent, specifying start and stop dates.

ALL medications must be delivered to the school by the parent/guardian in its original box or container. Medications delivered to the school nurse by the student will not be accepted for use, but will be placed in a locked cabinet until the parent/guardian picks up the medication or signs for it.

## From the School Nurse (continued)

Prescription medication containers must include the following: name of the student, student's date of birth, name of medication, directions for use, time for dispensing, name of health care provider ordering the medication, date of prescription, expiration date as stated by the pharmacist, and strength of the medication/dosage. The first dose of non-emergency medications must be given outside of school without problems.

**Students may not possess, dispense, or distribute medication on their own. Under special circumstances, individual students may be authorized by their physician to carry and self-administer emergency medications. In this case, the school nurse must be consulted.**

Non-medicated cough drops may be administered to a student with a note from his/her parents. Students must bring them in a bag with their name on it to the health room. A physician's order is not required.

### *Requirements for food allergy/bee sting allergy requiring emergency medications:*

- Medication administration form signed by the student's licensed health care provider, parent, and school nurse (at drop off).
- Food Allergy Action Plan form signed by the student's licensed health care provider.

### *Requirements for asthma requiring medications:*

- Medication administration form signed by the student's licensed health care provider, parent, and school nurse (at drop off)
- Asthma action plan. This plan may be substituted for the ordering health care provider's preferred asthma action plan form.

### *Requirements for prescription medications:*

- Medication administration form signed by the student's licensed health care provider, parent, and school nurse (at drop off).
- Medication must be dropped off/refilled in the original bottle provided by the pharmacy.
- A pill count will be performed by the school nurse and the parent/guardian for every controlled substance drop off/refill.

### *Requirements for over-the-counter medications:*

- Medication administration form signed by the student's licensed health care provider, parent, and school nurse (at drop off).
- Medication must be in the original, sealed container.

## Required Immunizations for the 2024-2025 school year

### Kindergarten & Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8:

- DTaP/DTP/DT/Td - 3 doses
- Polio - 3 doses
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) - 2 doses
- Varicella - 2 doses
- Hepatitis B - 3 doses

## From the School Nurse (continued)

Grades 7 & 8 ONLY:

- Tdap - 1 dose
- Meningococcal - 1 dose

According to Maryland School Immunization Regulations (COMAR 10.06.04), to be allowed in school, students must be immunized according to the Maryland Recommended Childhood Immunization.

*Students **without** medical or religious exemptions will have 20 calendar days from the start of school to present documentation of required immunizations OR proof of a scheduled doctor's appointment to receive missing immunizations. If the above documentation is not submitted, students with missing immunizations will be excluded from school until documentation is received.*
